ABOUT THE PROJECT

The goal of the Erasmus + project Art@Home is to develop and test artistic methods in domestic settings, offering vulnerable individuals a meaningful aesthetic, relational, and emotional experience.

The partnership brings together social and artistic organizations from Italy and France, with the goal to elaborate new forms of cultural inclusion.

Artistic workshop at home

In June and September 2025, the Art at Home Project artistic workshops were held in Italy and France.

Eight older people participated in theatre/dance workshops, opening the doors of their homes to dancers, musicians, actresses, and social workers. Objects, memories, and songs served as inspiration for the creation of tailor – made narratives and dramaturgies.

“I really enjoyed thinking about the people who owned the object I showed you. Especially my grand mother, whom I was very close to” (a participant to Italian workshop in June)

NEXT STEPS

In the coming months, the project will continue with:

- The documentation of experiences and evaluation of their impact, using shared indicators
- A focus group with the people involved in the workshop, to collect their feedback, emotions about that
- A final meeting in Modena in December to discuss outcomes and gather recommendations for the future.
- The co-creation of project methodology to implement artistic workshops at home,
